CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter the present writer presents her conclusions based on the result that she finds from her research. Besides, she also gives some suggestions which are needed for better improvement.

In general, both of the teachers motivate the students in learning English although they sometimes forget about the students' condition at aged of transition. The students at this aged find difficulty to pay attention to the lesson because they did not use their full attention in learning. The teacher can also make an interactive game which is involved all the students.

The present writer agrees that by changing aspects of personality, the teacher can understand their students' interest and also breaks the ice between his/her and the students. By using different kind methods of teaching, we can get our students' attention. This theory has been applied by the reading teacher.
