CONCLUSION

observe the class, so I will get the information about the boy. Then, I will consult with the home teacher also to learn from the home teacher's experience. After that, I will start to build a close relationship with the boy whenever necessary, I will discipline this boy in the classroom. As Wheeler states, "the success of assertive discipline depends on first establishing rapport with students" (52). That's why I should have the relationship first, and then I will discipline the boy. Moreover, I will use several moving activities such as guessing games, building blocks, or bouncing and catching balls. As a result, I will handle the boy effectively in the classroom.

As a conclusion, I have learnt that it is a challenge for me to learn how to handle the children effectively. I hope I can handle the boy in the classroom. Besides, there is a suggestion for teachers at Tumble Tots. I think it is important to give trainings to students who are going to have an internship. I believe that it can be more effective to teach and handle children.
