

## CHAPTER IV

### CONCLUSION

The problem that I faced when I was doing internship is I had difficulty in making a 4 year-old boy in Kindy A at *Anakku* Preschool & Kindergarten to concentrate while learning. Based on my analysis, I find three causes of the problem. The first cause the boy's developmental stage was behind his friends. The second is the boy felt inferior to his friends as he was aware that he was not as good as his friends in doing school works, and the third cause is the boy had a short attention span. Moreover, the problem brought two effects. The first is I felt frustrated while assisting him the lesson and second effect is the boy spent longer time to learn things. Based on the references, I provide three potential solutions that might help me to solve the problem. First, I will encourage to the boy to do the assignment by himself by breaking the tasks into chunks, second is I will give encouraging feedback to make the boy pay attention while learning the lesson. Third is I will position myself near the boy while learning. Thus, in this chapter I would like to propose the best potential solution to my problem.

Regarding the explanation above, I think the best solution to the problem is to combine all of the three of the potential solutions because everything is connect to one and another. During the learning process, I will divide tasks which

are difficult for the boy to smaller steps. I will sit near him to make it easy for me to monitor him. In order that he can be motivated to concentrate more on the lesson, I will give encouraging feedback, especially when the boy can finish the task given to him and when he can concentrate well when doing his task.

As a conclusion, having a four-year-old boy who had difficulty to concentrate while learning was a challenge for me. Therefore, I hope this term paper can inspire the readers who have similar difficulty in making the children concentrate during the lesson. Therefore, I would like to suggestion the teachers in *Anakku* Preschool & Kindergarten to try applying the potential solutions to handle the students with concentration problem.
