

CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION

The problem that I faced during my internship, which was handling two children aged four who were reluctant to do their task at *Anakku* Preschool & Kindergarten Bandung, has three causes. The first cause is the two children had difficulty with school readiness. The second cause is the two children were not capable of doing the task. The third cause is the two children were lacked of attention from the teacher. There are three effects of my problem. The first effect is the two children could not finish the task timely. The second effect is the two children had less time for playing as they could not finish their task on time. The third effect is I had to accompany the two children until they finished their task. I have three potential solutions to my problem. The first potential solution is I will provide interesting activities. The second potential solution is I will suit the task to the children's skill level. The third potential solution is I will give rewards to the children.

After analyzing the three potential solutions with their potential positive and negative effects, I decided to choose all of the potential solutions to solve my problem. If I only choose one or two solutions it will work but they do not give

the best result. These three potential solutions can be used together in every lesson. First, before I start the lesson, I will provide interesting activities to the students such as games. After that, I will give the students task which is suitable with their skill level. Then, I will give the students rewards after they finish doing the task. I hope by applying these solutions, the students will not be reluctant to do their task anymore and will be more motivated to do their task well.

By analyzing the difficulty in handling the two students who were reluctant to do their task at *Anakku* Preschool & Kindergarten, I can get knowledge about teaching techniques and how to motivate the students who are reluctant to do their task. I hope that the potential solutions can help not only me, but also the others who have the same problem and they can use them as a reference when facing students who are reluctant to do their task.
