CONCLUSION

The problem I faced on my internship is my difficulty in teaching a 4 year old boy in *Anakku Preschool & Kindergarten* who had concentration problem. In this term paper, I have analysed the causes and effects of my problem. The causes of my problem are I was not confident in teaching the boy, the boy was too dependent on me because he was being spoiled at home, and the boy was not ready for school yet. Besides the causes and effects of my problem, I have found some potential solutions that can be used to solve the problem. There are three potential solutions to solve the problem. The first potential solution of the problem is I will make preparation before the class. the three potential solutions that I have already discussed in the third chapter. Then, I will use the second potential solution which is I will encourage him to trust his capacity to build his confidence. The last, to make the boy easier to do the task, I will give instructions through toys, games, and music. The reason I choose the combination of these three potential solutions is because if I use the first and second potential solutions only, the boy will still not ready to go to school. If I only use the second and the third potential solutions, I will lack of preparation and I will probably still be nervous to teach the children. If I only use the first and the third potential solutions, the boy will be dependent and do what he wants only.

It also taught me that being a teacher and teaching students was never an easy job. Teachers need to be creative, patient yet assertive to apply the three potential solutions that I have already discussed.
