CHAPTER ONE

INTRODUCTION

BACKGROUND OF THE STUDY

Novel, as one of the literary genres, reflects human life and presents wellarranged events and settings. According to Shaw, novel is 'a lengthy fictitious prose narrative portraying characters and presenting an organized series of events and settings. Every novel is an account of life; every novel involves conflict, characters, action, setting, plot, and theme', (Shaw, 1972: 257). Novel is generally realistic, which concerns the everyday events of ordinary people, and is therefore concerned with characters. It is a representation of their lives, experiences, and learning. According to Robbert A. Harris, the important elements of a novel are action, discovery, and description, but the most important one is how the characters develop. And in this case I have chosen Joanne Greenberg's <u>I Never Promised You a Rose Garden</u> novel.

<u>I Never Promised You a Rose Garden</u> is a semi-autobiographical account of Joanne Greenberg's experience with mental illness. It is her best-known novel,

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and several of her other works also deal with the troubles that beset the handicapped. Greenberg used the pseudonym Hannah Green in order to protect her family from the stigma that often accompanies a psychiatric diagnosis. When Greenberg's family learned more about her history with mental illness, she allowed the book to be reprinted using her real name. In addition to the book making people aware of the stigma that comes with mental illness Greenberg wrote the book to give a realistic portrayal of the experience of mental illness.

Characterization techniques consist of personal description, character as seen by another, thoughts, speech, past life, conversation of others, reactions, direct comment and mannerism. By analyzing this literary work, I hope to discover more of how Joanne Greenberg portrays the protagonist in the novel as to show the purpose of the author in portraying the character Deborah in such way. It is hoped to give insights to other readers as a positive reference and further understanding of this book, its context, furthermore, of what lesson or moral the author is trying to convey by presenting the character in such manner.

STATEMENT OF THE PROBLEM

I would like to analyse the following problems:

- 1. What are the characteristics of the protagonist?
- 2. What techniques do the author use to portray the protagonist?
- 3. What is the author's purpose in creating the protagonist?

PURPOSE OF THE STUDY

Based on the statement of the problems above, the purposes of the study are formulated as follows:

- 1. To show the characteristics of the protagonist
- 2. To show the characterization technique used by the author to portray the protagonist.
- 3. To show the author's purpose to the protagonist.
