CHAPTER ONE INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the study

I prefer discussing a novel to a play or a poem because a novel contains more details as Shaw states 'Novel is a lengthy fictitious prose narrative portraying characters and presenting an organized series of events and settings.'(Shaw, 1972: 257).

Wally Lamb, whose surroundings were influenced mostly by girls, was given the inspiration and ability to observe the opposite gender, about their characteristics, feelings, points of view and response to lead their lives. He writes because he wishes to understand the world better along with its pain. I believe that this novelist is capable of writing about women's life, which makes this novel worth reading and analysing.
