1. First Speech: President Bush Address the Nation.

(1)" My fellow citizens, at this hour, American and coalition forces are in the early stages of military operation to disarm Iraq, to free its people and to defend the world from great danger. On my orders, coalition forces have begun striking selected targets of military importance to undermine Saddam Hussein's (5)ability to wage war. These are opening stages of what will be a broad and (6)concerted campaign. More than 35 countries are giving crucial support – from the use of naval and air bases, to help with the intelligence and logistic, too the deployment of combat units. Every nation in this coalition has chosen to bear the honor of serving in our common defense.

(10)To all the men and women of the United States Armed forces now in the (11)Middle East, the peace of a troubled world and the hopes of an oppressed people now depend on you. That trust is well placed.

The enemies you confront will come to know your skill and bravery. The people you liberate will witness the honorable and decent spirit of the American (15)military. In this conflict, America faces an enemy who has no regard for (16)conventions of war or rules of morality. Saddam Hussein has placed Iraqi troops and equipment in civilian areas, attempting to use innocent men, women and children as shields for his own military -- a final atrocity against his people.

I want Americans and all the world to know that coalition forces will make (20)every effort to spare innocent civilians from harm. A campaign on the harsh (21)terrain of a nation as large as California could be longer and more difficult than some predict. And helping Iraqis achieve a united, stable and free country will require our sustained commitment.

We come to Iraq with respect for its citizens, for their great civilization and (25)for the religious faiths they practice. We have no ambition in Iraq, except to (26)remove a threat and restore control of that country to its own people.

I know that the families of our military are praying that all those who serve will return safely and soon. Millions of Americans are praying with you for the safety of your loved ones and for the protection of the innocent. For your (30)sacrifice, you have the gratitude and respect of the American people. And you (31)can know that our forces will be coming home as soon as their work is done.

Our nation enters this conflict reluctantly -- yet, our purpose is sure. The people of the United States and our friends and allies will not live at the mercy of an outlaw regime that threatens the peace with weapons of mass murder. We will (35)meet that threat now, with our Army, Air Force, Navy, Coast Guard and (36)Marines, so that we do not have to meet it later with armies of fire fighters and police and doctors on the streets of our cities.

Now that conflict has come, the only way to limit its duration is to apply decisive force. And I assure you, this will not be a campaign of half measure, and (40)we will accept no outcome but victory. My fellow citizen, the danger to our (41)country and the world will be overcome. We will pass through this time of peril and carry on the work of peace. We will defend our freedom and we will prevail. May God bless our country and all who defend her."

2. Second Speech: Combat Operations in Iraq Have Ended

(1) Thank you all very much. Admiral Kelly, Captain Card, officers and sailors of the USS Abraham Lincoln, my fellow Americans: Major combat operations in Iraq have ended. In the battle of Iraq, the United States and our allies have prevailed. And now our coalition is engaged in securing and reconstructing (5)that country.

(6)In this battle, we have fought for the cause of liberty, and for the peace of the world. Our nation and our coalition are proud of this accomplishment -- yet, it is you, the members of the United States military, who achieved it. Your courage, your willingness to face danger for your country and for each other, made this day (10)possible. Because of you, our nation is more secure. Because of you, the (11)tyrant has fallen, and Iraq is free.

Operation Iraqi Freedom was carried out with a combination of precision and speed and boldness the enemy did not expect, and the world had not seen before. From distant bases or ships at sea, we sent planes and missiles that could (15)destroy an enemy division, or strike a single bunker. Marines and soldiers (16)charged to Baghdad across 350 miles of hostile ground, in one of the swiftest advances of heavy arms in history. You have shown the world the skill and the might of the American Armed Forces.

This nation thanks all the members of our coalition who joined in a noble (20)cause. We thank the Armed Forces of the United Kingdom, Australia, and (21)Poland, who shared in the hardships of war. We thank all the citizens of Iraq who welcomed our troops and joined in the liberation of their own country. And tonight, I have a special word for Secretary Rumsfeld, for General Franks, and for all the men and women who wear the uniform of the United States: America is (25)grateful for a job well done.

(26)The character of our military through history -- the daring of Normandy, the fierce courage of Iwo Jima, the decency and idealism that turned enemies into allies -- is fully present in this generation. When Iraqi civilians looked into the faces of our servicemen and women, they saw strength and kindness and (30)goodwill. When I look at the members of the United States military, I see the (31)best of our country, and I'm honored to be your Commander-in-Chief.

In the images of falling statues, we have witnessed the arrival of a new era. For a hundred of years of war, culminating in the nuclear age, military technology was designed and (30)deployed to inflict casualties on an ever-growing scale. In (35)defeating Nazi Germany and Imperial Japan, Allied forces destroyed entire (36)cities, while enemy leaders who started the conflict were safe until the final days. Military power was used to end a regime by breaking a nation.

Today, we have the greater power to free a nation by breaking a dangerous and aggressive regime. With new tactics and precision weapons, we can achieve (40)military objectives without directing violence against civilians. No device of (41)man can remove the tragedy from war; yet it is a great moral advance when the guilty have far more to fear from war than the innocent. (Applause.)

In the images of celebrating Iraqis, we have also seen the ageless appeal of human freedom. Decades of lies and intimidation could not make the Iraqi people (45)love their oppressors or desire their own enslavement. Men and women in (46)every culture need liberty like they need food and water and air. Everywhere that freedom arrives, humanity rejoices; and everywhere that freedom stirs, let tyrants fear.

We have difficult work to do in Iraq. We're bringing order to parts of that (50)country that remain dangerous. We're pursuing and finding leaders of the old (51)regime, who will be held to account for their crimes. We've begun the search

for hidden chemical and biological weapons and already know of hundreds of sites that will be investigated. We're helping to rebuild Iraq, where the dictator built palaces for himself, instead of hospitals and schools. And we will stand with (55)the new leaders of Iraq as they establish a government of, by, and for the Iraqi (56)people.

The transition from dictatorship to democracy will take time, but it is worth every effort. Our coalition will stay until our work is done. Then we will leave, and we will leave behind a free Iraq.

(60)The battle of Iraq is one victory in a war on terror that began on (61)September the 11, 2001 — and still goes on. That terrible morning, 19 evil men -- the shock troops of a hateful ideology -- gave America and the civilized world a glimpse of their ambitions. They imagined, in the words of one terrorist, that September the 11th would be the "beginning of the end of America." By (65)seeking to turn our cities into killing fields, terrorists and their allies believed (66)that they could destroy this nation's resolve, and force our retreat from the world. They have failed.

In the battle of Afghanistan, we destroyed the Taliban, many terrorists, and the camps where they trained. We continue to help the Afghan people lay roads, (70)restore hospitals, and educate all of their children. Yet we also have (71)dangerous work to complete. As I speak, a Special Operations task force, led by the 82nd Airborne, is on the trail of the terrorists and those who seek to undermine the free government of Afghanistan. America and our coalition will finish what we have begun. (75)From Pakistan to the Philippines to the Horn of Africa, we are hunting (76)down al Qaeda killers. Nineteen months ago, I pledged that the terrorists would not escape the patient justice of the United States. And as of tonight, nearly one-half of al Qaeda's senior operatives have been captured or killed.

The liberation of Iraq is a crucial advance in the campaign against terror. (80)We've removed an ally of al Qaeda, and cut off a source of terrorist funding. (81)And this much is certain: No terrorist network will gain weapons of mass destruction from the Iraqi regime, because the regime is no more. In these 19 months that changed the world, our actions have been focused and deliberate and proportionate to the offense. We have not forgotten the victims of September the (85)11th -- the last phone calls, the cold murder of children, the searches in the (86)rubble. With those attacks, the terrorists and their supporters declared war on the United States. And war is what they got.

Our war against terror is proceeding according to principles that I have made clear to all: Any person involved in committing or planning terrorist attacks (90)against the American people becomes an enemy of this country, and a target (91)of American justice.

Any person, organization, or government that supports, protects, or harbors terrorists is complicit in the murder of the innocent, and equally guilty of terrorist crimes.

(95)Any outlaw regime that has ties to terrorist groups and seeks or (96)possesses weapons of mass destruction is a grave danger to the civilized world -- and will be confronted.

And anyone in the world, including the Arab world, who works and sacrifices for freedom has a loyal friend in the United States of America.

(100)Our commitment to liberty is America's tradition -- declared at our (101)founding; affirmed in Franklin Roosevelt's Four Freedoms; asserted in the Truman Doctrine and in Ronald Reagan's challenge to an evil empire. We are committed to freedom in Afghanistan, in Iraq, and in a peaceful Palestine. The advance of freedom is the surest strategy to undermine the appeal of terror in the (105)world. Where freedom takes hold, hatred gives way to hope. When freedom (106)takes hold, men and women turn to the peaceful pursuit of a better life. American values and American interests lead in the same direction: We stand for human liberty.

The United States upholds these principles of security and freedom in many (110)ways -- with all the tools of diplomacy, law enforcement, intelligence, and (111)finance. We're working with a broad coalition of nations that understand the threat and our shared responsibility to meet it. The use of force has been -- and remains -- our last resort. Yet all can know, friend and foe alike, that our nation has a mission: We will answer threats to our security, and we will defend the (115)peace.

(116)Our mission continues. Al Qaeda is wounded, not destroyed. The scattered cells of the terrorist network still operate in many nations, and we know from daily intelligence that they continue to plot against free people. The proliferation of deadly weapons remains a serious danger. The enemies of (120)freedom are not idle, and neither are we. Our government has taken

(121)unprecedented measures to defend the homeland. And we will continue to hunt down the enemy before he can strike.

The war on terror is not over; yet it is not endless. We do not know the day of final victory, but we have seen the turning of the tide. No act of the terrorists (125)will change our purpose, or weaken our resolve, or alter their fate. Their (126)cause is lost. Free nations will press on to victory.

Other nations in history have fought in foreign lands and remained to occupy and exploit. Americans, following a battle, want nothing more than to return home. And that is your direction tonight. After service in the Afghan -- and (130)Iraqi theaters of war -- after 100,000 miles, on the longest carrier (131)deployment in recent history, you are homeward bound. Some of you will see new family members for the first time -- 150 babies were born while their fathers were on the Lincoln. Your families are proud of you, and your nation will welcome you.

(135)We are mindful, as well, that some good men and women are not (136)making the journey home. One of those who fell, Corporal Jason Mileo, spoke to his parents five days before his death. Jason's father said, "He called us from the center of Baghdad, not to brag, but to tell us he loved us. Our son was a soldier."

(140)Every name, every life is a loss to our military, to our nation, and to the (141)loved ones who grieve. There's no homecoming for these families. Yet we pray, in God's time, their reunion will come.

Those we lost were last seen on duty. Their final act on this Earth was to fight a great evil and bring liberty to others. All of you -- all in this generation of (145)our military -- have taken up the highest calling of history. You're defending (146)your country, and protecting the innocent from harm. And wherever you go, you carry a message of hope -- a message that is ancient and ever new. In the words of the prophet Isaiah, "To the captives, 'come out,' -- and to those in darkness, 'be free.'"

(150)Thank you for serving our country and our cause. May God bless you (151)all, and may God continue to bless America.

The road to success: The Veronicas kicked off their career 15 years ago, but international success is a new prospect. After signing a publishing deal with Multiplay Music in Brisbane, during 2003, the girls' first demo then got them a deal with Engine Room (the artist "finishing school" production company that has had the Vines and Holly Valance on its roster). "They sent us on a big songwriting world tour – where we visited and wrote in Sweden, London, New York, Canada and L.A. – developing our songwriting and recording demos."

Label made: With the help of David Sonenburg's management (the team behind the Black Eyed Peas and John Legend), the Veronicas emerged from a label bidding war with a world deal – they signed on the dotted line with Warner's U.S. company Sire. "We surround ourselves with people that love us for us – regardless of what we're doing or where we are." And, of course, some wise words along the way helped. "We got advice from our dad – 'Be nice to everyone on your way up, because you're going to want them to be nice to you on your way down!""

The album: The girls are now in Los Angeles recording their debut album, Secret Life of the Veronicas, which lands on shelves in September. The first taste of it, the sincerely hook-laden single, "Forever", is out later this month. Their drawcard is wonderful. disarming harmonies over popdriven guitar melodies that come together to shape a sound not easy to pigeonhole. From Juliana Hatfield to Lisa Loeb to Avril Lavigne without the cynical angst, the Veronicas have an edge that's sadly lacking from a lot of leading female chart stars. "The stuff we listen to doesn't necessarily come out in our music." Once, it was AC/DC and Skyhooks that did it for them. And now? "It's bands like the Used, Juliana Theory, My Chemical Romance, Buchanan

and Jimmy Eat World." Bright future: On the rise, the girls are keeping their feet on the ground. "We recently got advice from one of our favourite bands, and that was to keep it real and make music for ourselves – because, in the end, you can't please everyone."
