with Schizophrenia. She had to spend some time in the psychiatric hospital and

Hetty. But one of her writings, entitled A Battle Within, is inspired by her own

story. In the novel, Macfarlane shares about her ups and downs when she has to

fight against her illness. A Battle Within is a semi-biographical novel, which tells

about a woman who suffers from Schizophrenia; besides, it is her only non-fiction

work.

After recovering from Schizophrenia, Macfarlane becomes a member of

Lutheran church, based on Steeple church in Dundee city centre in England. She

works there as a parish nurse who focuses on serving health needs for church and

community.
