

## CHAPTER IV

### CONCLUSION

To support the two solutions I will use also the third solution which is using some varieties in teaching. By using teaching aids and varying the teaching technique the students can concentrate more on the lesson.

The combination of those three solutions is useful to help the student get focus on the lesson, because those three solutions support one another. If I only tell them to stop, the students might not listen to what I said. In orders to help them gain their concentration I give them a break. However, sometimes it is useless by only giving a break if the same technique is still used in teaching. The students might get bored with the common teaching technique, therefore I use some varieties to get their attention and this will help them to concentrate on the lesson. I am sure that the combination of those three solutions is very effective to help them to concentrate on the lesson.

In conclusion, if we use the solution which I give in this term paper I believe that it will help them to concentrate. If the students get their concentration back, the process of the learning will be easier. The student will also understand the material better.
