CHAPTER IV CONCLUSION

After doing some observation at Kids Talent International Preschool and Kindergarten, I found that the main problem that makes Kids Talent hard to develop their Preschool is their teachers' lack of competence in teaching. The current teaching competence of the teachers at Kids Talent sometimes makes some parents feel unsatisfied and create negative thoughts about the school. Beside that, it creates a negative atmosphere in class and can affect the children's development in learning. To avoid this problem from becoming worse, the school must act quickly by improving the teachers' teaching competence in every aspect. The purpose of improving teachers' competence in teaching is to help the school develop their institution and to increase teachers' quality in teaching. After analyzing the possible solutions in the previous chapter, and based on the condition at Kids Talent International Preschool and Kindergarten, the best solution that I propose to solve the problem of incompetence of teachers at Kids Talent is improving teachers' interaction with the children.

Improving teacher's interaction with the children is the best solution that

can give give profit both to children and teachers. Based on Learning to Teach (18), if teachers develop authentic human relationship with their students, they can motivate students to be engaged in the learning process and accomplish their teaching goals. With this simple solution, the problem of both children and teachers can be solved at once. Another profit is this solution does not cost much to accomplish it.

To conclude, teachers' teaching competence is important to be improved, especially for those who teach young children, because it will determine the children's future. I suggest that the teachers at Kids Talent start to improve their teachers' teaching competence by trying to create interaction with children in various ways so it will give profit to the school's development and make the school well prepared in the midst of tight competition among preschools.
